Start by cutting out all area labeled 1 on your block. Ink block with the next numbered color and pull 5 prints. Cut out the next numbered space and repeat step 5&6 overtop the 5 previous prints. Choose your best print and adhere it to you a larger paper with your partners. |

Part 5 Printing

Time Needed:

1-2 days
