Essential Learnings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students can demonstrate persistence through problem-solving and response to mistakes in artwork.• Students can communicate personal voice by making creative and individual decisions in their artwork.

Lesson Steps	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Choose three compound words and look up 6 images to go with those words.2. Cut out 3 of the objects from the side pictures and paste them into the 3 main pictures.3. Manipulate your images and blend your edges together with the blend tool.4. Add some extra Imagery and text to each compound word image.5. Merge all three pictures into one final document, save as a jpeg and submit to schoology.

How to do a proper google image search and where to save <p><u>Things to Consider:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Try to find larger pictures rather than smaller <p><u>Work Task:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Choose 3 compound words, then find 6 pictures to match
Part 2 Cutting & Pasting	<p><u>Time Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 3-4 days <p><u>Lesson Targets:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• I can complete artwork in a focused manner. <p><u>Materials Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adobe Photoshop CS6 <p><u>What to Cover:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Opening Images2. Selection tools3. Cutting (Ctrl + X) Copying (Ctrl + C) Pasting (Ctrl + V)4. How to move pictures around.

	<p><u>Things to Consider:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cut out the picture with the most boring background <p><u>Work Task:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cut out 3 of the 6 pictures and paste them into the other three.
Part 3 Manipulating and Blending	<p><u>Time Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2-3 days <p><u>Lesson Targets:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• I can complete artwork in a focused manner. <p><u>Materials Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adobe Photoshop CS6 <p><u>What to Cover:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. How to free transform (Ctrl +T)2. How to merge two layers together3. How to use the blend tool <p><u>Things to Consider:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are hotkeys for just about everything <p><u>Work Task:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Change the size of your added layer, merge the two layers, blend both together using the blur tool.
Part 4 Extra Imagery and Text	<p><u>Time Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 3-4 days <p><u>Lesson Targets:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• I can complete artwork in a focused manner. <p><u>Materials Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adobe Photoshop CS6• Chrome Browser <p><u>What to Cover:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Finding new images to go with the current one.2. Cutting pasting and blending again3. Using the Type tool to type out your word. <p><u>Things to Consider:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It must be the horizontal type tool <p><u>Work Task:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Add 2 more images to each of your three compound words, blend them all, and then write the names of the compound words on each.
Part 5 Merging and Saving	<p><u>Time Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 day <p><u>Lesson Targets:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• I can complete artwork in a focused manner. <p><u>Materials Needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adobe Photoshop CS6• Chrome Browser <p><u>What to Cover:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. How to merge all layers together2. Saving as a jpg format3. Uploading to schoology <p><u>Things to Consider:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• This is going to be the same process for everything <p><u>Work Task:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Merge all layers, save as a jpg, upload to schoology.
