Lesson Name	Lyrics Art
Essential Learnings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students can communicate personal voice by making creative and individual decisions in their artwork.• Students can demonstrate persistence through problem-solving and response to mistakes in artwork.
Lesson Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adobe Photoshop CS6, Chrome Browser
Lesson Steps	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Choose 2 songs that represent a major event in your life.2. Choose two nouns (person, place, or thing) that could represent those songs.3. Find a picture for each one of those nouns, save them, and then open them in photoshop.4. Cut and paste your two nouns into a new document set at 8 in x 12 in5. Change the mode of your new image to grayscale, then up the contrast until there is only black and white showing.6. Search online to find the lyrics of the songs that you chose earlier and copy them into a word or google doc.7. Paste your lyrics in text boxes overtop of your nouns, rasterize the text, then warp that text to fit inside of the black space.8. Delete your layers that contain your nouns, save image as a jpg image and upload to schoology.

Positive and negative space2. Putting a text box over the negative space.3. Rasterize your text, then warp text to the shape of the negative space.4.
