Lesson Materials	 Wood Scotch Tape Wire Hot Glue Paint Plastidip
Lesson Steps	 Choose a sport that is obscure and a pose for someone to do in that sport. Start creating a metal armature from wire. Use the stiff wire for the skeleton, and the flimsy wire for the muscles. Wrap your armature in masking tape to start to fill in the structure. Spray your armature in plastidip. Spray your armature with spray paint Decorate your base to your preference, and attach armature.
